



General Appearance

1. Students

All students must keep short, Clean and unvarnished finger nails.

Students who wear spectacles must not use tinted lenses unless for medical reasons. Spectacles with fanciful rims are disallowed.

Rings, necklaces, pendants, lockets, bracelets or any other forms of jewellery must not be worn to school. Plain, simple identical ear studs may be worn by girls only one on each ear lobe.

2. Boys

Hair must be short and neatly combed. Hair should not touch the ears, eye - brows or the shirt collar. It should be cropped at the back of the head and show evidence of a slight slope. No streaking / dyeing of hair, perms or punk hairstyles. Sideburns must not extend beyond the middle of the ear. There should be side-parting.

3. Girls

The Fringe should not touch the eye-brows. No perfumes are allowed. Colouring or streaking of hair is also not permitted. No form of make-up is allowed. Long hair must be neatly plaited or tied up with black clip only.

Guidelines for the Students:

- 1. Students should converse only in English inside the school campus.
- 2. Students are expected to be polite in their speech and courteous in their actions at all times.
- 3. Students are expected to greet their teachers, non teaching staff and guests of the school.
- Students should avoid taking leave without prior intimation or valid reason
- If students take leave for more than 5 days, they should produce a medical certificate.
- 6. Students must carry their identity card, diary, books according to their time table everyday.
- 7. Students are not allowed to wear silver or gold ornaments to school at any situation.
- 8. Running, loitering, shouting around the classroom or corridor is forbidden.
- 9. Students are not permitted to bring handphones, telecommunication, electronic equipment, CD, board / Card games.
- 10. Students should take considerable care of the school property and their own property.
- 11. Students are not allowed to leave the school campus during school hours without proper & prior permission
- 12. Students are not allowed to leave the classroom without the permission pass issued by the teachers.
- 13. Students Should go home immediately after dismissal and NOT loiter around premises or near the school (eg. HDB void deck areas, park, pavilions, etc)
- 14. Students are not allowed to play games in their school uniform. Proper PE attire should be worn.
- 15. Students are not allowed to enter the OFFICE and STAFF ROOM at all times.

Guidelines for the parents:

- 1. Parents are requested to check the diary everyday for messages or remarks and sign after going through them.
- 2. A parent must attend parent teachers conferences and school functions. It is essential for a parent to keep track of their child's progress in academics as well as his / her performance in activities.
- 3. Parents / Guardians are requested not to meet their children or call on the teacher during class hours.
- 4. Parents are requested not to call up teachers at their residences.
- 5. The latest school information will be sent to the parents through news letter.
- 6. Parents are requested to take necessary care at home to ensure that the child is well groomed and dressed neatly before coming to school.
- 7. Parents are requested not to wear gold ornaments for their children. In case of loss the school will not take up the responsibility.
- 8. Please report a change of address to the school office at the earliest convenience.
- 9. Parents are requested not to give any medicine to the child without a note in the diary to the class teacher.
- 10. Report cards must be returned to the class teacher duly signed within two days.

Rules for Library

- 1. Silence should be observed in the library at all times.
- 2. Students should not bring any book of their own into the library except their notebooks and a pen or pencil.
- 3. Books should be returned on or before the due date indicated on them without fail. Delay in doing so will result in a fine of Re.1 per day, per book.
- 4. Books can be renewed for a period of one week, provided if the book is not in great demand.
- The librarian has the right to recall a book from students or staff at anytime, even before the due date indicated on them.
- 6. Before leaving the library, books to be borrowed must be carefully examined by the student. He/She should report any damage to the book to the librarian immediately. A fine will be levied on books that are found damaged on return.
- 7. If a book is lost, it must be replaced at once or duly compensated for.
- 8. Reference books such as the dictionary and encyclopedia cannot be borrowed.
- 9. No book, magazine or newspaper shall be taken out of the library without the permission of the librarian.
- 10. The issuing of books will be stopped 15 days before the end of the current academic year for stock taking and checking.

Rules for Laboratory:

- 1. Silence should be observed while doing practical work in the laboratory.
- 2. The instructions given by the teacher and the laboratory assistant must be followed.
- 3. Students will be responsible for any breakage or loss of the apparatus used in the experiment. Any breakage or loss should be reported immediately to the teacher-in-charge. The cost of breakage should be paid by the student.
- 4. Students should bring proper record books and observation note books to the laboratory and immediately record all observations after the experiments are performed.
- 5. Students should hand over the chemicals and apparatus used for the experiment to the teacher when the experiment is over. They should not bring or take any chemicals or instruments into or from the laboratory.
- 6. Students should strictly adhere to the safety rules and regulations in the laboratory.

REMITTANCE OF FEES

- 1. All fees should be paid at the office before the Schedule date of every term.
- 2. Those who fail to remit the fee on time will be treated as defaulters and is not eligible for attendance until all dues are cleared.
- 3. Fee, once paid, is non-refundable.
- 4. Fee can be remitted in advance only by cash. Cheques are not accepted.
- 5. All money transactions to the school should be done before 4.30 p.m. in the school office
- 6. Van fee receipts should be kept for reference.

School Transport:

Transport facility is available to all students on request for a safe journey to school and back to home. The following rules shall be followed by the students.

- 1. Courteous and gentle behaviour inside and outside the school premises is expected from each and every student.
- 2. All Students using the school bus shall be at the bus stop atleast five minutes before the expected time of arrival of the bus. The bus shall not wait for late comers.
- 3. Students must travel only on the routes allotted to them by the transport in-charge.
- School transport once requisitioned shall be valid for the whole quarter.
 Midterm cancellations shall not be entertained and transport fees shall not be refunded.

- 5. Do not stand in front of or behind a stationary bus.
- 6. Do not run to the bus but walk in single line.
- 7. Do not jump into or off a moving bus.
- 8. Do not push each other when you get on or off the bus.
- 9. Do not stretch your head or hands out of the window.
- 10. Do not litter the bus or throw anything out of it.
- 11. No Student shall come near the door of the bus until it has made a complete stop.
- 12. Students shall maintain discipline in the bus. Any mischief or an intemperate outburst may divert and disturb the driver. Thus, unruly behaviour is strictly prohibited.
- 13. Co-operate with staff on duty and abide by the instructions given by them, from time to time.
- 14. Students violating the above rules shall be strictly punished which may include suspension or expulsion from the school.
- 15. It is mandatory for students to wear the school identity card while boarding the school bus.

Co-Curricular Activities

Introduction

As Co-Curricular Activities are regarded as an integral part of our education system, the school plans and implements a programme consistent with our national educational objectives. Through CCA, we hope to nurture a generation of students who are well-disciplined in body and mind, who have the capacity to live and work together happily with others and who can appreciate the goodthings in life.

AIM

- The aim of CCA is to provide for healthy recreational activity towards teaching students skills and at the same time cultivate correct values and desirable social attitudes in the individual.
- Participation in CCA is compulsory. Students are offered a wide range of activities which caters to their varied interests and abilities. The activities offered are classified under the following.

Physical Education

The aims and objectives of the PE Programme are to develop the cognitive and affective domains such that students emerge as life long practitioners of a healthy lifestyle. They will be able to plan their own fitness programmes, participate in wide range of skills and be exposed to opportunities of leadership and responsibilities.

PE Rules

- Students who are unable to attend PE lessons must produce a medical certificate or letter signed by their parents.
- Students are to wear only the school T-shirt and shorts. The T-shirts must be neatly tucked in. Footwear is compulsory (white canvas or track shoes must be worn with socks).
- Students must report immediately to the teacher if any injury sustained during the lesson.
- 4. At the end of the class students are to wash up. They must return to the class in an orderly manner and they are not allowed to loiter.
- 5. No equipments is to be taken out of the PE store without the permission of the PE teacher.
- 6. All PE equipments are to be handled with care, returned immediately after the lesson and stored in the proper places.
- Class PE Rep is responsible for the borrowing and returning of equipments.
- 8. Any loss or damage to the equipment must be reported to the PE teacher immediately.

Evaluation Pattern

Evaluation for the pre-primary is a continuous process based on the work sheets, class work and home work done throughout the year.

Grade I to V are assessed on the basis of continuous comprehensive evaluation with the tools and techniques designed by CBSE

Grade VI to X or evaluated consistently through periodic test and also Terminal Examination.

The system is intended to provide holistic profile of the learner in scholastic and co - scholastic areas it is spread over two semesters during the academic year.

In addition to this life skill, attitudes and values achievements in activities involving literature and Creative skills, scientific skills, aesthetic skills, performing arts, health and physical education will also be evaluated.

The term also refers diagnosis of learning gaps and providing remedial measures to enhance levels of learning while providing support to students so that they can develop/improve their skills.
